

Contract for Services Rendered

This is a contract entered into by **Wholesome Foods Farm** (hereinafter referred to as “the Provider”) and **Root Cellar Foods** (hereinafter referred to as “the Client”) on this date, **April 15, 2015**.

The Provider’s place of business is **P.O.Box 596 Bridger, MT 59014** and the Client’s place of business is **200 Briar Place, Belgrade, MT 59714**

The Client hereby engages the Provider to provide services described herein under “Scope and Manner of Services.” The Provider hereby agrees to provide the Client with such services in exchange for consideration described herein under “Payment for Services Rendered.”

Scope and Manner of Services

Services to Be Rendered:

1. Provider has agreed to grow 1,600 lbs of Butternut Squash for the Client during the 2015 Growing Season.
2. Provider will arrange 2 separate shipments of 800 lbs each to Billings, MT (exact location TBD later) where the Clients distribution transportation can pick it up. Each Client and Provider will cover her own end of distribution.
3. The Butternut Squash shall be in good condition and up to standards laid out b/w the Provider and Client. These standards include, but aren’t limited to, no rotten spots, no mold, or major bruising.
4. The Client has agreed to purchase the 1,600 lbs of Butternut Squash as long as the harvest is successful.

Payment for Services Rendered

The Client shall pay the Provider for services rendered at an agreed up rate of \$0.75/pound within **30** calendar days of the date on any invoice for services rendered from the Provider.

Should the Client fail to pay the Provider the full amount specified in any invoice within **30** calendar days of the invoice’s date, a late fee equal to **\$75** shall be added to the amount due and interest of **10%** percent per annum shall accrue from the **15th** calendar day following the invoice’s date.

This contract is null and void only if there is either a weather condition, catastrophe or other circumstance that keeps the Provider from being able to grow and harvest the amount of Butternut Squash stated above. The only circumstance that would keep the client from purchasing the squash would be a legal declaration of bankruptcy.

Applicable Law

This contract shall be governed by the laws of the County of Gallatin in the State of Montana and any applicable Federal law.
